All our training is free for staff, volunteers and decision makers who work in East Lothian and Midlothian.

Training Courses

Look at our Course Descriptors to see what course is suitable and necessary for your role. Before applying, ensure you have your manager's approval, and protected time to attend and read any pre-course materials.

Most courses are booked via the East Lothian and Midlothian Public Protection Office. Details of each course and how to apply are included in the flyer for each course which is advertised approximately 12 weeks before the date. Registration for courses is open from 12 weeks in advance of the date.

Our training calendar is updated monthly. This includes information about whether the training is in-person (and the venue) or on-line (Microsoft Teams).

Each course will have a maximum number of spaces. Most courses are offered on a first come, first served basis unless there is a high demand, when they will be agreed according to individual need and priority as agreed with your service.

If you are allocated a space on a course, the joining instructions and any pre-course materials will be sent one week in advance.

We are keen to make sure that all spaces are filled, and if you are unable to attend, please contact emppo@eastlothian.gov.uk at the earliest opportunity to let us know if you can no longer attend.
